Hi Everyone!

I hope your semester is going well!

I am writing to you as the Chair of the AAUP Minority Recruitment and Retention Committee (MRRC). Dr. Close has indicated that you are all eligible to apply for and receive AAUP MRR funds this academic year.

I wanted to reach out and let you know that this year we have been able to keep the same maximum amount of funds per year, \$1,000.00, despite the fact that our pool of recipients has grown. This is good news. We hope you take advantage of this opportunity to apply for funds to supplement your scholarship and/or teaching. As you may know, you are eligible to apply for these funds every year up to the year you become tenured. The main purpose of this financial support is to enhance your scholarship and teaching, and ultimately enhance your application for tenure. That said, there are a number of ways in which you may use AAUP MRR funds. While many use funds for travel to conferences, you will see there is a non-exhaustive list of other uses at the end of the application. Have an idea? Please send it our way.

A few things to keep in mind:

- 1)The maximum amount is \$1,000 per year but you can apply for those funds in increments over the year.
- 2) Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Please send them to me.
- 3) If you use the funds for travel you must first apply for and use your department's AAUP Travel funds.
- 4) The application and reports on past funded projects can be found on our website--link below.
- 5) We ask that you write and send a brief report on how you used the funds after your project is complete. You can email those to Dr. Close and me.
- 6) The AAUP MRRC also releases funds for recruitment. If there is a search in your department, please remind the search chair that they may apply for funds to bring in minority candidates. They should look for that application on our website, as well.
